Bible-First Lifestyle reading: Job 37-42; Is. 8-14; Titus

1. Be **ready** to do good!

*"In everything set them an example by doing what is good." Titus 2:7*

*"Remind the people to...be ready to do whatever is good." Titus 3:1*

2. Be **eager** to do good!

*"Jesus Christ gave Himself for us to redeem us from all wickedness and to purify us for Himself a people that are His very own, eager to do what is good." Titus 2:14*

3. Be **devoted** to doing good!

*"Stress these things so that those who have trusted in God may be careful to devote themselves to doing what is good." Titus 3:8*

*"They claim to know God, but by their actions they deny Him, They are detestable, disobedient, and unfit for doing anything good." Titus 1:16*

4. **Learn** to be devoted to doing good!

*"Our people must learn to devote themselves to doing what is good." Titus 3:14*

## Practical Principles of Doing Good

*"I wish to do something great and wonderful, but I must start by doing the little things like they were great and wonderful." - Albert Einstein*

- Be ready to do the **spontaneous** thing
- Be eager to do the **deliberate** thing – Think ahead, plan ahead, pray ahead
- Be devoted to **make a life** of doing good – Investment of time, treasure and talent
- What could I do today to help someone have a better life?
- What people in my life do I know who could use a helping hand?
- Who is better off because I am in their life?
