

“Never, Ever, Ever Quit! How to Persevere in Prayer”

1. Persistent prayer is based on the **character** of God.

“If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much, more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him?” Luke 11:1-13

2. Persistent prayer must be **humble**.

““Yes, Lord, but even the dogs eat the crumbs that fall from their master’s table. The Jesus answered,” Woman you have great faith! Your request is granted.”” Matt. 15:21-28

3. Persistent prayer is based on **faith** in God.

“Will not God bring about justice for His chosen ones...Will He keep putting them off?...However, when the Son of Man come, will He find faith on the earth?” Luke 18:1-8

4. The time to quit prayer is when God has made clear **His answer**.

“Going a little farther, He fell with His face to the ground and prayed...Then He returned to the disciples and said to them, “Are you still sleeping and resting? Look, the hour is near, and the Son of Man is betrayed into the hands of sinners. Rise, let us go!”” Matt. 26:36-46

5. If you persist in prayer be prepared to **walk differently**.

“I will not let you go unless you bless me. He touched the socket of Jacob’s hip so that his hip was wrenched as he wrestled...and he was limping because of his hip.” Genesis 32:22-32
