

The Romans Road - Practical steps to leading someone to Christ

"I tell you the truth, unless a man is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God." John 3:3

Step 1 – The Problem: We are sinners, separated from God, in need of a Savior

Rom. 3:10 – "There is no one righteous, not even one."

Rom. 3:23 – "For all have sinned and have fallen short of the glory of God."

Rom. 6:23a – "The wages of sin is death..."

Step 2 – The Solution: Jesus Our Savior

Rom. 6:23 – "The wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Jesus Christ our Lord.

Rom. 5:8 – "But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us."

Step 3 – The Decision: Confession and Acceptance by Faith

Rom. 10:9 – "That if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead you will be saved."

Rom. 10:13 – "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

Step 4 – Your New Life: Family, Security and Accountability

Rom. 8:15-17 – "You received a spirit of sonship. And by Him we cry Abba, Father. The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children."

Rom. 8:38-39 – "(Nothing) can separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord."

Rom. 12:1-2 – "Therefore, I urge you brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God – which is your spiritual worship. Do not be conformed any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is – His good, pleasing and perfect will."
