

What Would Jesus Say To A Spiritual Seeker?

John 3:1-21

1. There is more to what we see in our earthly reality. There is a spiritual realm that is more real than the physical world. Understanding and knowing God comes through the Spirit.

“Unless a person is born again, he cannot see the Kingdom of God...Unless a person is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the Kingdom of God...The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit.” Vs 1-8

2. Jesus is the entryway into life in the Spirit. Believing in Christ includes trusting Him and submitting all to Him.

“For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believe in Him will not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him.” Vs 9-17

3. Without belief in Jesus, there is nothing left except eternal separation from God and all that is God.

“Whoever believes in Him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God’s one and only Son.” Vs 18

4. What holds most people back is they don’t want to admit they are evil and as far from God as they really are.

“This is the verdict: light has come into the world...Everyone who does evil hates the light, and will not come into the light for fear that his deeds will be exposed...” Vs 19-21

What do you think?

1. Admit there is something more out there, something much more than you and your experiences.
2. Be willing to take a step of humility, acknowledging you’re not perfect and you need God’s grace.
3. Tell Jesus you believe in Him. You don’t have to have everything figured out.
4. Start reading the Bible, praying and attending church gatherings in order to learn how to grow in your relationship with God.
