Romans Road –

Romans 3:10 – There is no one righteous, not even one.

Romans 3:23 – For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

Romans 5:8 – But God demonstrated His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners Christ died for us.

Romans 6:23 – For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 8:1 – Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

Romans 10:9 – That if you confess with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

Romans 10:13 – Everyone who calls upon the name of the Lord will be saved.

The Condition of Israel –

- Israel was zealous but misdirected.
- Israel sought their own righteousness apart from the righteousness of God.
- Israel searched for righteousness not realizing God was near and accessible by faith.
- Israel saw and heard the message of faith but refused Jesus.
- As a result of Israel’s rejection of God, the door is opened to the Gentiles.
- Though Israel is disobedient and obstinate, God is patient, continuing to reach out to them.

The Good News –

- The Word is near you; it is your mouth and in your heart.
- Confess with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord”.
- Believe in your heart God raised Jesus from the dead.
- All who call on Jesus will be saved.

“Confession without belief is vanity; belief without confession is spurious.” John Stott

The Excuse –

- One cannot call on God if he doesn’t believe in Him.
- One cannot believe in Jesus, if he has never heard of Him.
- One cannot hear if no one preaches to him.
- One cannot preach unless he is sent.

4 reasons why the church must Cultivate, Plant, Water, & Harvest –

1. The command from above: Mt. 28:18-20 - “Go into all the world and make disciples...”

3. The call from without: Acts 16:6-10 - “Come over and help us...”
4. The compelling from within: 2 Cor. 5:14 - “Christ’s love compels us...”
