Romans Road

Romans 3:10 – There is no one righteous, not even one.

Romans 3:23 – For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

Romans 5:8 – But God demonstrated His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners Christ died for us.

Romans 6:23 – For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

- Preserve the Purity
 - Two kinds of obedience
 - Blind obedience
 - Discerning obedience
 - Be experts in good; not even beginners in evil
