The Great Co-Mission

"Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹ Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

"Fishers of men" = "Go and make disciples"

When we make disciples...

- We go in the power and the presence of God.
- We baptize in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
- We teach and mentor people to be able to go and make more disciples.

A disciple is someone who adheres to another's teaching; a follower or a learner who takes up the ways of another under that person's authority.

Mission Marker 3 - Purpose: "We are devoted to making new followers of Christ; LIFERS reach out! "

- We are devoted to growing the family.
- We are devoted to mentoring others.
- We are devoted to being led by the Holy Spirit to allow God to work through us.

4 Ways you can become fishers of men in 2022

4. Ask the Lord to lead you to the people He is already talking to.
