- Record of wrong an accounting for future reference
- Trust put faith in
- Hope expect the best
- 1. Love doesn't keep score.

"Blessed are they whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered. Blessed is the man whose sin the Lord will never count against him." Rom. 4:7-8

- We keep score to determine who wins or loses.
- The one who runs to the cross first wins.

"Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord..." Acts 3:19

2. Love trusts while being wise.

"But Jesus would not entrust Himself to them, for He knew all man...He knew what was in a man." Jn. 2:24-25

- Love quenches wrongs, it does not record them.
- Love trusts the Holy Spirit to do His work while judging the fruit of a person.

3. Love hopes while exercising discernment.
